- Opt into a discussion group that includes farm walks on local properties with livestock owners from your area (six sessions over 2019-20)
- Access to technical assistance and funding support for on ground works from Melbourne Water
- Targeted support to assist you design and achieve holistic goals and actions for your property

- Upper Deep Creek Catchment (townships of Newham, Rochford, Lancefield, Romsey, Goldie, Springfield, Darraweit Guim and surrounds, etc.)
- Upper Werribee, Lerderderg and Little River Catchments (townships of Ballan, Ingliston, Greendale, Pentland Hills, Coimadai, Bullengarook and Balliang and surrounds)
